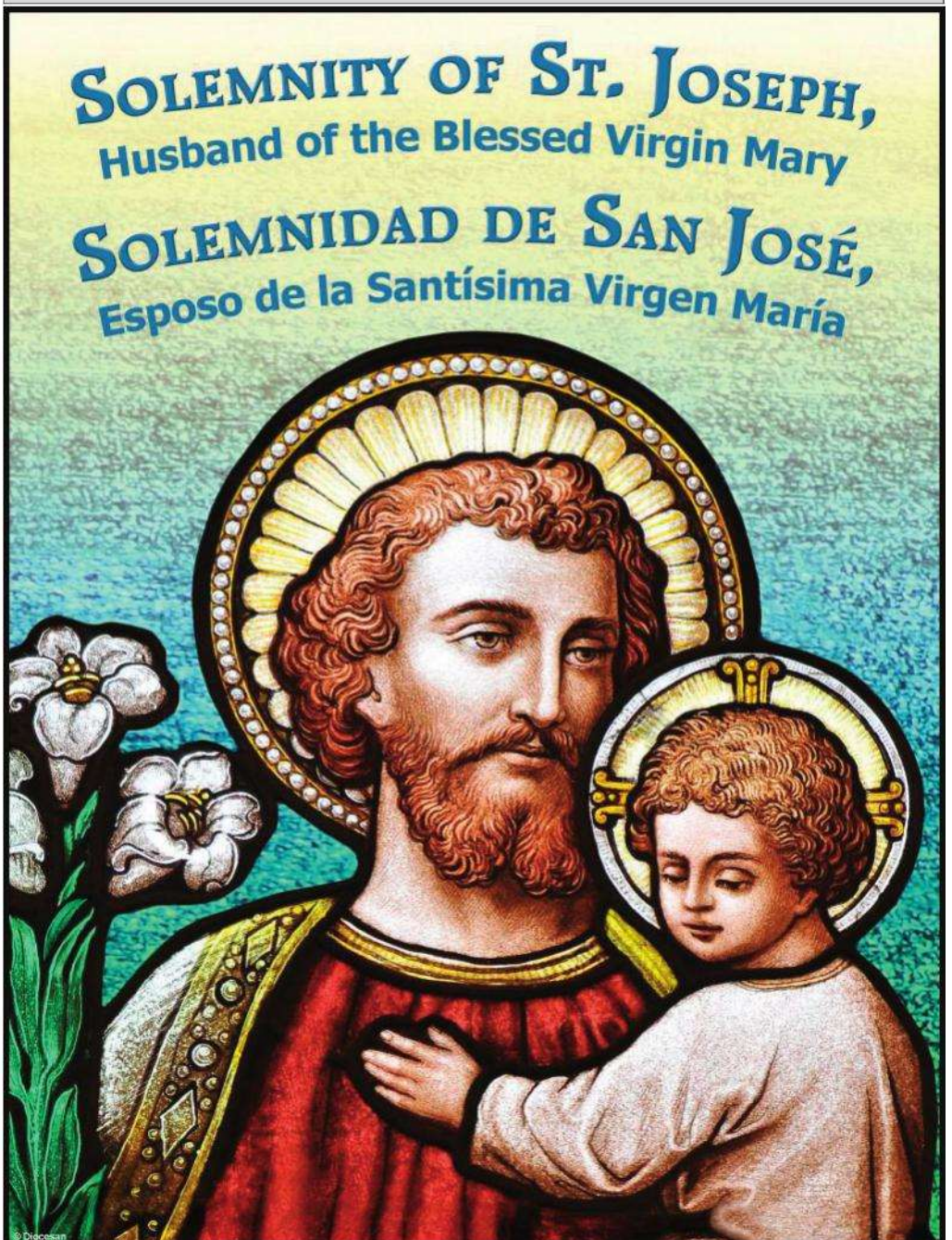

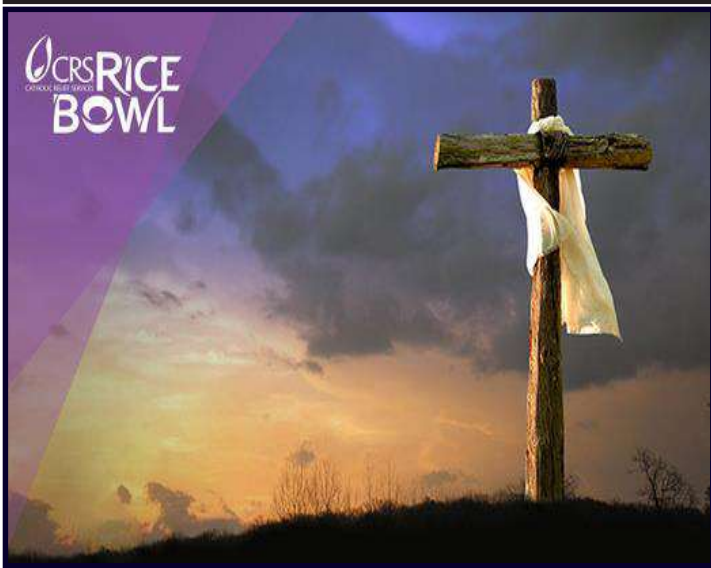

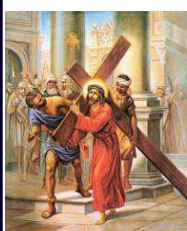
“I will be their God and they shall be my people.”- Jeremiah 31:33

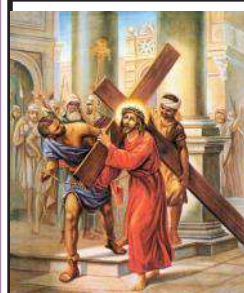
