

CCD Class Information 2021-2022

- The registration period begins July 1, 2021 until September 12, 2021.
- Registrations received by 4:00pm August 31, 2021 will qualify for a \$10.00 registration discount per child
- Class size is limited this year, so registrations are on a 'first come, first serve' basis.
- Registration is REQUIRED for all students, new and returning students. NO EXCEPTIONS
- Documents needed to register for CCD include:
 - Completed registration form signed by both parents or legal guardians
 - Registration fee, unless prior arrangements have been made
 - Copy of Birth certificate for new registrants
 - Copy of Baptismal certificate for new registrants
 - Copy of First Communion certificate (for Confirmation candidates)
 - Signed behavior & dress code & acknowledgement of receipt of Parent/Student Handbook form
 - If the fee presents a financial hardship to the family, please contact the church office for assistance.
 - Checks should be made out to St. Henry Church.

- CCD students meet Sundays in the Parish Hall.
- English class students should arrive by 9:45am and Spanish class students should arrive by 11:45am on scheduled class days.
- Students are to arrive on time and dressed appropriately for class and Mass.
- Students are to bring a folder with paper and pencil or pen to class each week.
- Please make sure to communicate with your CCD teacher should your child not be able to attend a class.
- Students planning on receiving a Sacrament (First Reconciliation, First Communion or Confirmation), must complete two sequential years of CCD instructions prior to receiving the Sacrament.
