- Participate in the ABCD diocese campaign.
- Be a student in good standing with their school and church.
- Be active in the life of the parish.
- Be attending an elementary, middle, high school, or an accredited two or four year college/university and with a passing grade.
- Provide 2 reference letters from a teacher AND 1 reference letter from a school administrator (such as a principal), including reference contact information.
- Provide the most recent transcripts or report card.
- Application deadline is June 15, 2024.
- Successful applicants will be announced on St. Henry's Feast Day – July 13, 2024.
