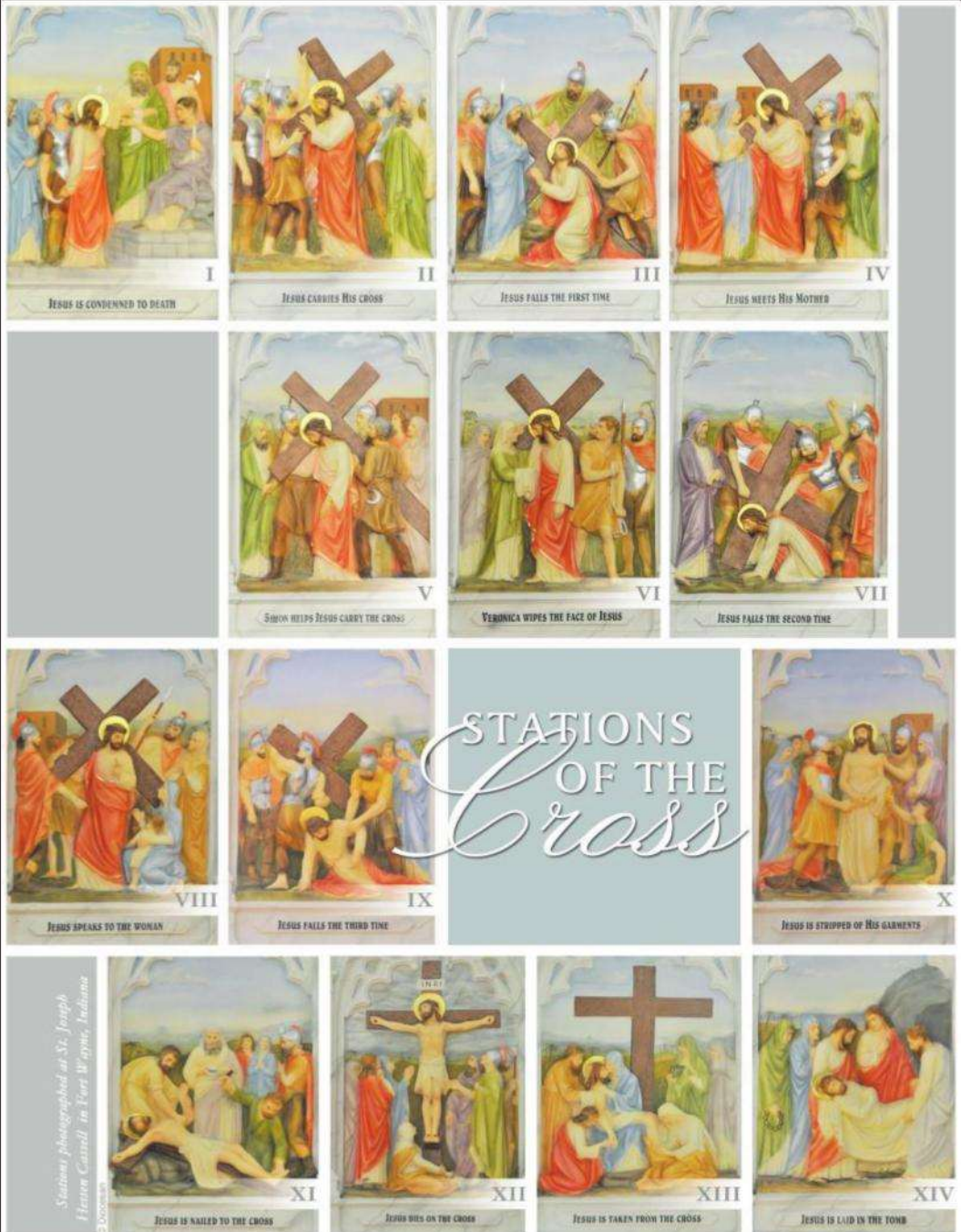

### NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC PILGRIMAGE 2025



During the summer of 2024, an unprecedented National Eucharistic Pilgrimage moved from the four corners of the United States to Indianapolis, culminating in the 10<sup>th</sup> National Eucharistic Congress. To keep the momentum going in 2025, there will be another Pilgrimage this summer.

We are excited to share the route, dates and some exciting events planned for this *Pilgrimage* which will launch from Indianapolis May 18<sup>th</sup>, 2025 along the *Drexel Route*. This year's Pilgrimage will cover nearly 3,340 miles and include 20 dioceses before concluding in Los Angeles for the Feast of Corpus Christi on June 22<sup>nd</sup>. The Drexel Route will feature many unique stops, including the tomb of Archbishop Fulton Sheen, the Shrine of Blessed Stanley Rother, and the historic Catholic Missions of California.
