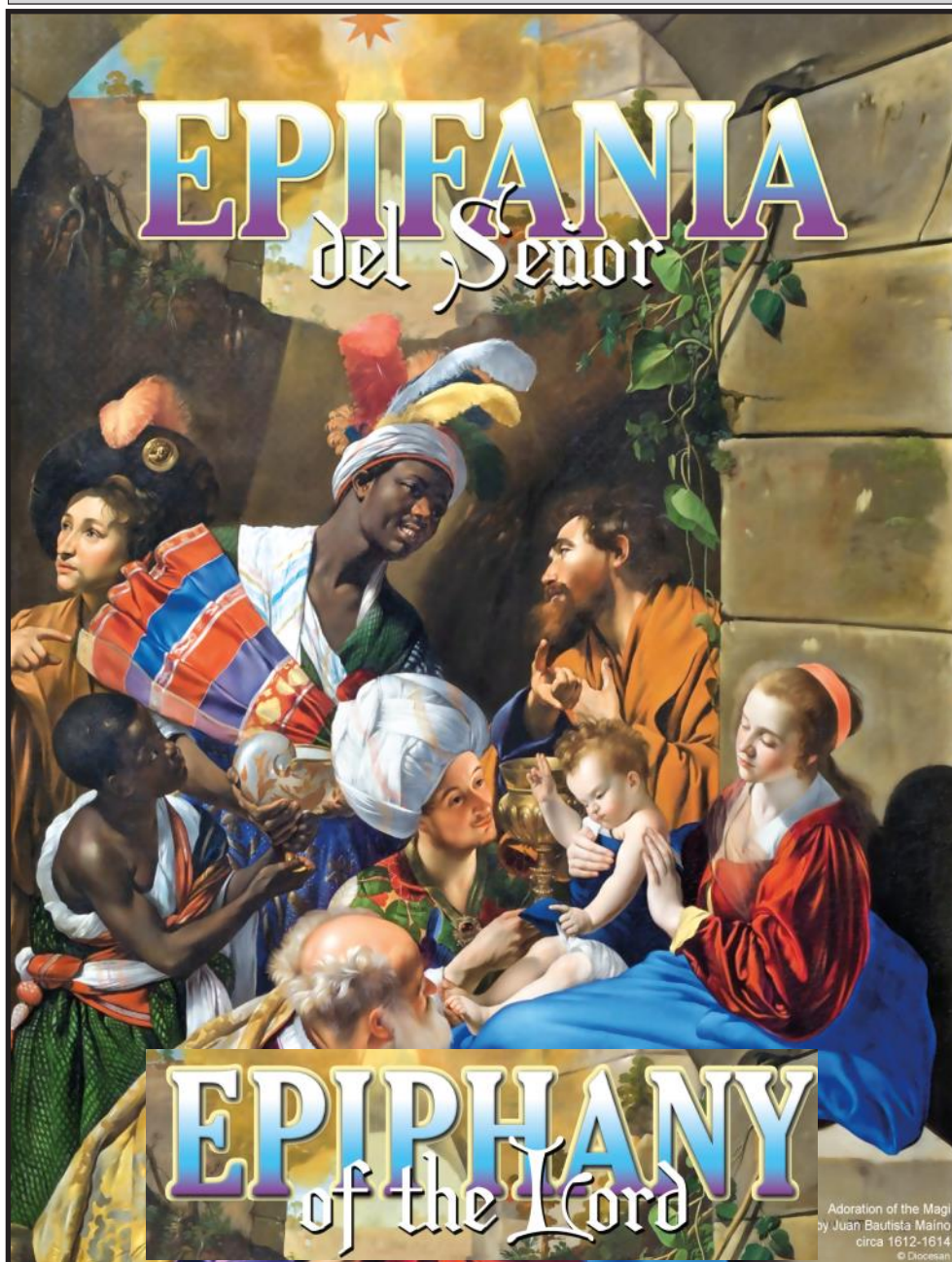

Offerings for the Tabernacle Lights, Wine and Altar Bread are available beginning this month. Contact the church office to schedule a Mass intention or offering today.

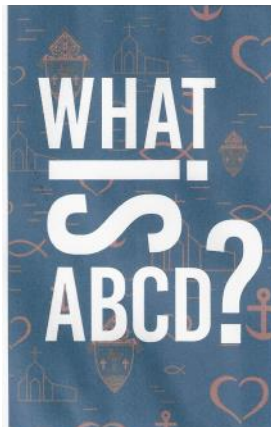


A Huge Thank You to all who contributed Christmas Gifts for our Toy Drive this year.

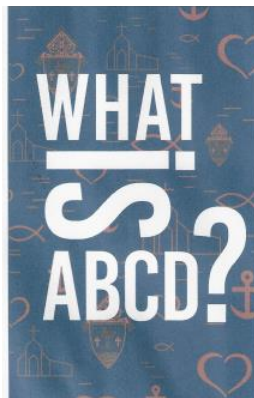
