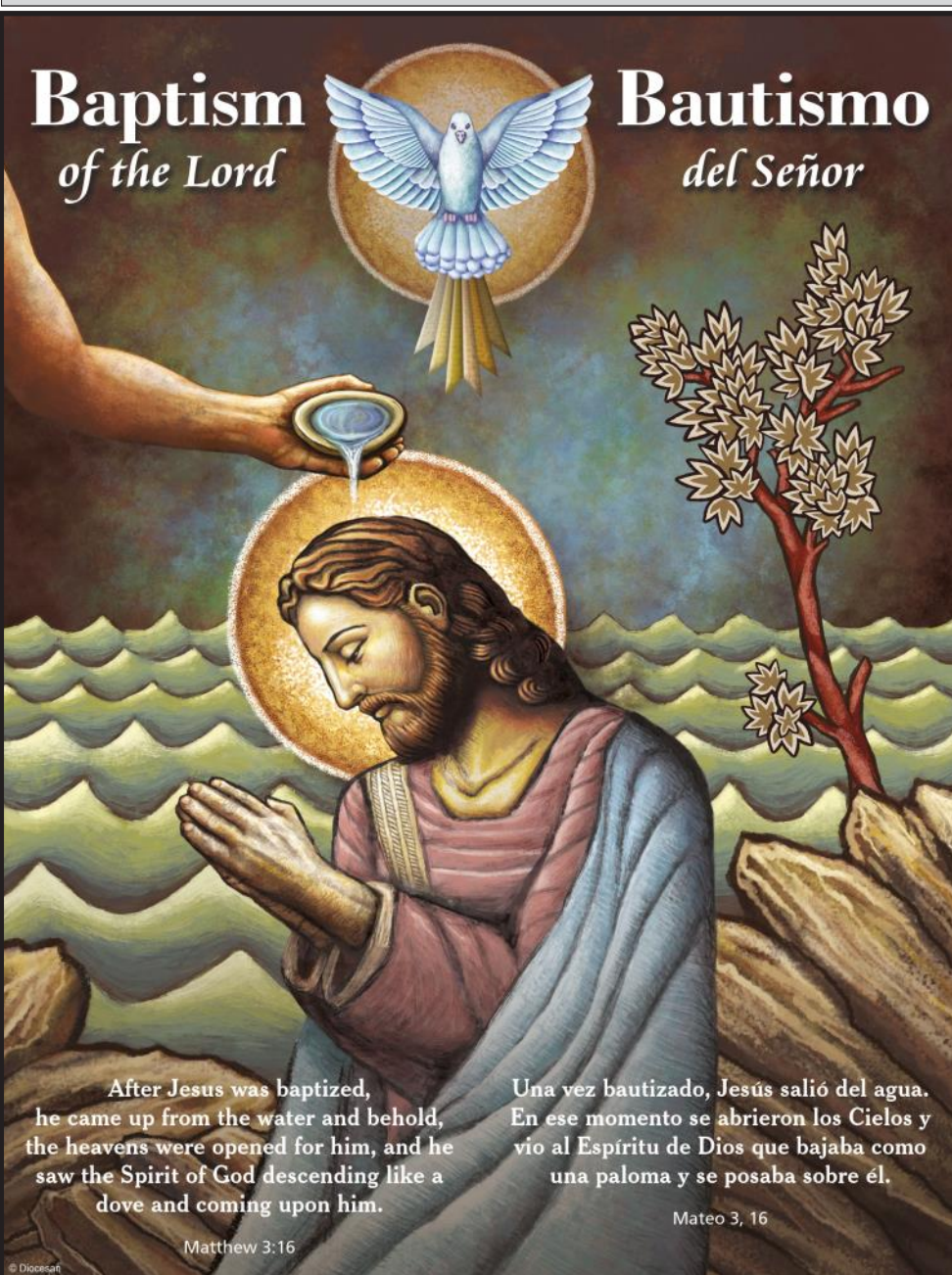

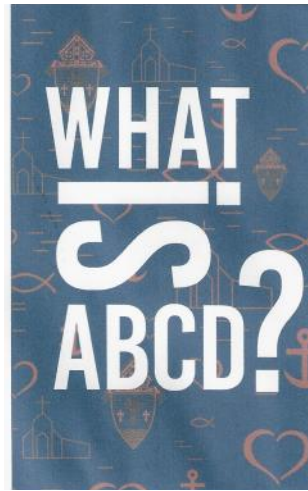
Offerings for the Tabernacle Lights, Wine and Altar Bread are available beginning this month. Contact the church office to schedule a Mass intention or offering today.

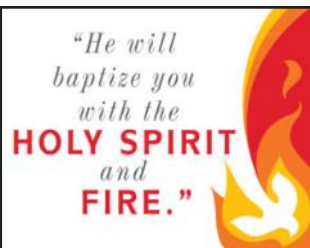

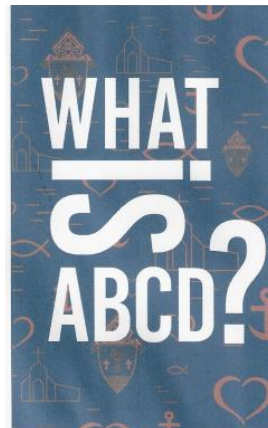
### Ser miembro activo de la parroquia es importante
