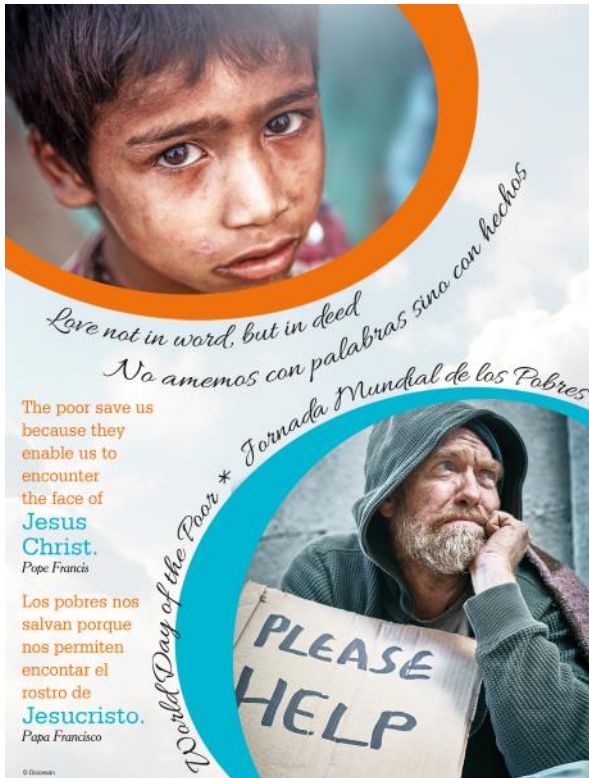

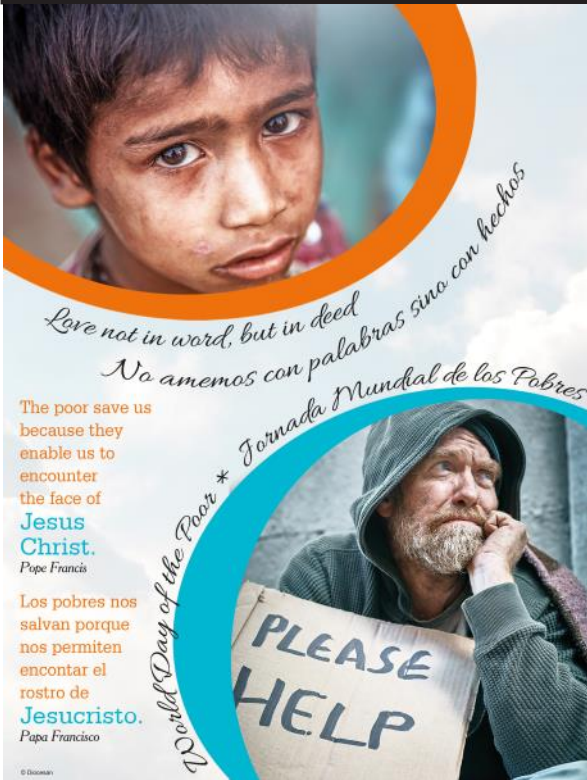
Church Safety Protocol Updates / Actualizaciones del Protocolo de Seguridad de la Iglesia
