

From the Pastor:

HOLY WEEK

“THEY CLOSED THE TOMB AND ALL DEPARTED”

HOLY WEEK begins with the commemoration of the solemn entrance of Christ into Jerusalem to accomplish the mystery of our redemption. During this week we take our time to meditate on the sufferings He went through for our salvation. There will be Masses as usual Monday thru Wednesday each followed by the opportunity by confessions.

EASTER TRIDIUM

The last three days of the Holy Week are extraordinarily important. On Holy Thursday we commemorate Christ institution of the sacramental or ministerial priesthood. Only Chrism Mass is usually celebrated in the morning. At the Mass, bishops and priests renew their sacred commitment to the Lord. In the evening we celebrate the Solemn Liturgy of the Lord’s last supper. We recall his betrayal and the institutions of the Holy Eucharist. To give clergy and laity of the Archdiocese of Miami enough time to prepare for this big event celebration, the Archbishop has transferred the Chrism Mass to Tuesday, March 26. The Mass will begin at 10:30am and us all can go, will witness the blessing of the holy oils of the sick, the catechumen and the Chrism.

On Good Friday, Mass is not celebrated. It is a day of meditation on the suffering of the Lord, a day of penance with fasting and abstinence. Our love in action urges us to give what we save from fasting and abstinence to the maintenance of the Holy Land where Jesus walked, suffered, died and rose from the dead. “Support of the Holy Land is a Duty. Good Friday collection is an Urgent Need” (Commissaries of the Holy Land in the United States.) We shall take up a collection for the Holy Land both at the celebration of the Veneration of the Cross at 3:00pm and 7:00pm.

On Holy Saturday, from morning until sundown, our Church invites us to continue with penance and meditation at the tomb of the Lord. Although Mass is not celebrated, our quiet Church will be open for individuals and groups for prayers. We adore You, O Christ and we praise You! Because, by Your Holy Cross, “You have redeemed the world” should continue to resonate from our hearts and lips. Let us not to close the tomb and depart. The Easter Vigil begins after nightfall. Our Archdiocese directive requires us to follow this rule strictly. This year we shall begin at 8:00pm with the service of the light outside the doors of the main entrance to the Church.
