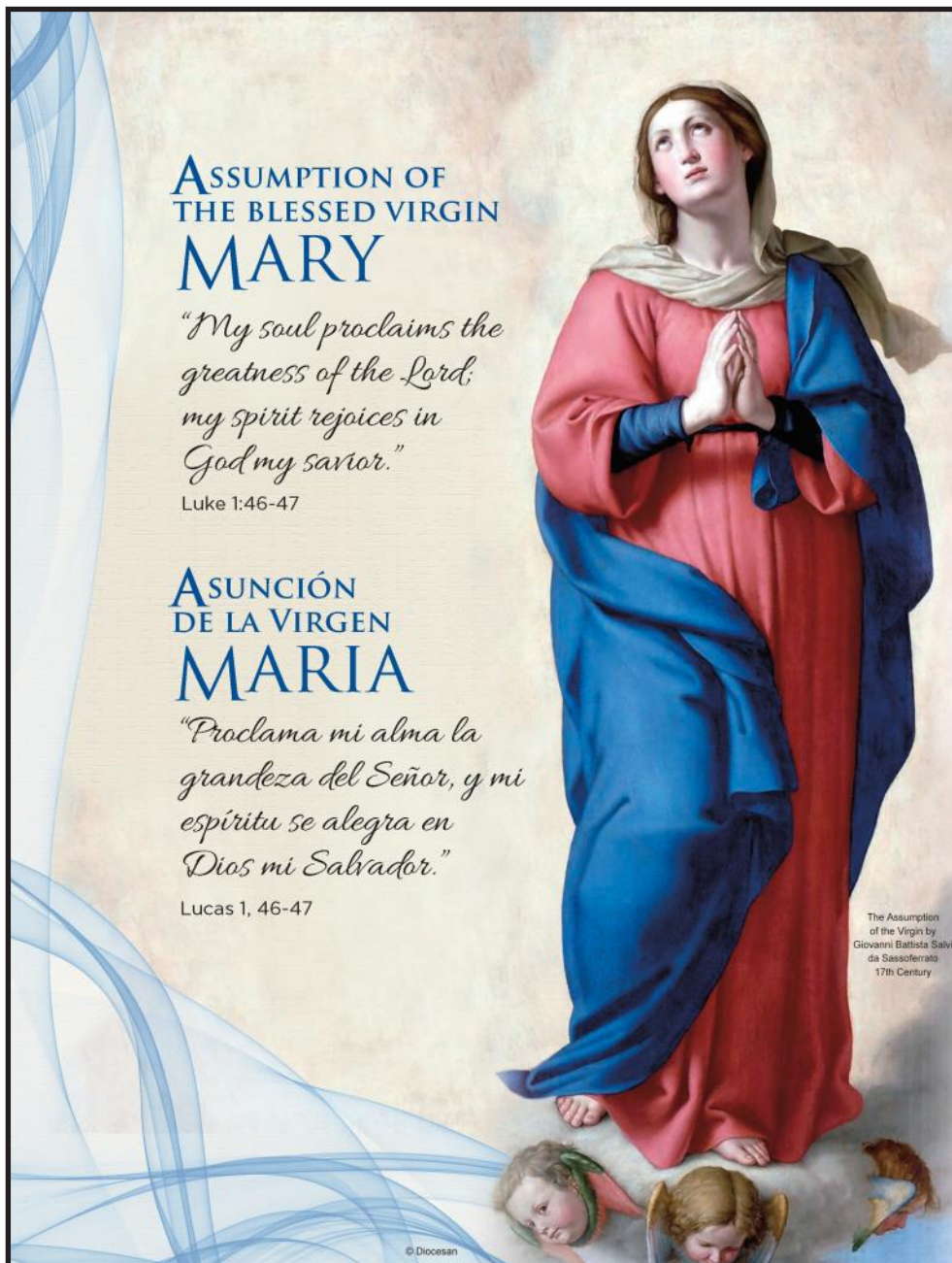

## The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary

After the building of the Church of the Holy Sepulchre in 336, the sacred sites began to be restored and memories of the life of Our Lord began to be celebrated by the people of Jerusalem. One of the memories about his mother centered around the "Tomb of Mary," close to Mount Zion, where the early Christian community had lived.

On the hill itself was the "Place of Dormition," the spot of Mary's "falling asleep," where she had died. The "Tomb of Mary" was where she was buried. At this time, the "Memory of Mary" was being celebrated. Later it was to become our feast of the Assumption.

At the Council of Chalcedon in 451, when bishops from throughout the Mediterranean world gathered in Constantinople, Emperor Marcian asked the Patriarch of Jerusalem to bring the relics of Mary to Constantinople to be enshrined in the capitol. The patriarch explained to the emperor that there were no relics of Mary in Jerusalem, that "Mary had died in the presence of the apostles; but her tomb, when opened later . . . was found empty and so the apostles concluded that the body was taken up into heaven."

All the feast days of Mary mark the great mysteries of her life and her part in the work of redemption. The central mystery of her life and person is her divine motherhood, celebrated both at Christmas and a week later (Jan. 1) on the feast of the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God. The Immaculate Conception (Dec. 8) marks the preparation for that motherhood, so that she had the fullness of grace from the first moment of her existence, completely untouched by sin. Her whole being throbbled with divine life from the very beginning, readying her for the exalted role of mother of the Savior.

The Assumption completes God's work in her since it was not fitting that the flesh that had given life to God himself should ever undergo corruption. The Assumption is God's crowning of His work as Mary ends her earthly life and enters eternity. The feast turns our eyes in that direction, where we will follow when our earthly life is over.

In 1950, in the Apostolic Constitution *Munificentissimus Deus*, Pope Pius XII proclaimed the Assumption of Mary a dogma of the Catholic Church in these words: "The Immaculate Mother of God, the ever-virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul into heaven."

La enseñanza es que siempre estemos atentos para servir y que en los problemas de la vida y en las dificultades del servicio, llamemos a Jesús, es decir, que oremos, que contemos a Jesús el problema y seguro vendrá la solución, no la que quisiéramos, sino la que Dios quiere.

El Evangelio de hoy nos narra la visita a Isabel, quien le dice: "*dichosa tú que has creído*". Es como si nos estuviera diciendo, dichosos nosotros, si confiamos en Dios, porque tendremos confianza en nosotros mismos, en el servicio a los demás.

María le respondió con la oración del Magnificat, que la rezan todas las tardes los ministros ordenados: Ella ora por nosotros asegurándonos la misericordia de Dios para toda la humanidad: "*Santo es su nombre y su misericordia llega de generación en generación a los que lo temen*" y su oración se convierte en un llamado a nuestra liberación y de toda la humanidad: "*dispersó a los de corazón altanero*"

Previamente, proclama su seguridad en la acción de Dios quien está en favor de los humildes, es decir, de los que no se sienten poderosos ni autosuficientes. Ella dice: "*Mi alma glorifica al Señor y mi ESPÍRITU SE LLENA DE JÚBILO EN DIOS, mi salvador, porque puso sus ojos en la humildad de su esclava*".
