We approach the sacred texts today by reminding ourselves that Jesus is the face of God made visible, the wisdom of God revealed and the One who daily challenges the quality of our discipleship. Much of the Lucan Gospel is set against the backdrop of a journey. Jesus and his disciples were slowly but surely making their way to Jerusalem, where his reason for being would be revealed to all. On their way, Jesus continued the formation of his disciples, telling of both the blessings and the struggles entailed in following him. As he teaches, Jesus' words and wisdom reach out to us across the centuries and make us disciples, as well, if we listen and are willing to learn and commit ourselves to him today in every way.

Just as Jesus' teaching offered an ultimatum of sorts to his first disciples, so also does he extend the same choice to us. We are advised to weigh carefully the cost of discipleship before setting out to follow Jesus on the journey. Ours is not a safe and secure religion demanding only our Sunday-morning attention and devotion. To take it seriously is to walk a rocky path. These steps are necessary to move us forward toward the goal of professing and witnessing to Jesus with our lips as well as our lives.

Like the builder of the tower and the king marching into battle, disciples must understand what they are about — what are the costs, what are the consequences, and do I have what it takes to be a disciple and see the journey through to the end? Left to our own devices, the answer to this question would, unfortunately, be a negative one. However, we are not alone. With God and with grace, with Jesus' constant presence and guidance in the person of the Holy Spirit, we are empowered to take one step at a time. With God and with grace, we can learn to put on the mind of Christ and be fired by the Holy Spirit to take on our ministry one person, one challenge at a time. With God and with grace, we can keep our priorities straight and pool our resources with those of other disciples, always keeping uppermost, in mind and heart, the claim of Jesus in our lives. One step, one day at a time.

TODOS SOMOS VIP

En la segunda lectura, el apóstol Santiago, nos pide que *“que no tengan favoritismo”*, por tanto, no hay prójimos de primera o segunda categoría, sino que simplemente todos somos prójimos, sin diferencias de clase económica, social, religiosa o política, ni siquiera por afinidad entre amigos o con quienes tenemos relaciones de amistad o familiar, porque todos los que aman a Dios son herederos del Reino de Dios,

Se debe resaltar lo siguiente: el Reino de Dios, se manifiesta en la actitud que tiene en la vida cada persona. La atención al marginado o al que sufre, NO es el Reino de Dios, pero si es la manifestación del Reino en la persona que sirve al necesitado, pues hace visible para todo el que lo quiera ver, la misericordia de Dios.

El sordo y el mudo en el Antiguo Testamento era simbólicamente, quien no creía o no podía escuchar la Palabra de Dios y por tanto no la cumplía; en el Evangelio, son símbolo de la incomprensión y/o resistencia al mensaje de Jesús.

Jesús vive en medio del pensamiento del Antiguo Testamento de los judíos, y por tanto esas carencias físicas significaban que las fuerzas del mal prevalecían en las personas discapacitadas pues pensaban que Dios los había abandonado, por tanto, eran marginados o excluidos religiosos. La actitud de Jesús es contraria a esto. Se acerca al discapacitado, sin importarle si cree o no cree en Dios, si son buenas a o malas personas, sin hacer proselitismo para que se conviertan al judaísmo, sino para hacer presente el Reino de Dios en Él, con su obra y su predicación.

El Reino de Dios no es posible si existe la exclusión eso se debe manifestar en nuestra vida, saliendo de nuestro egoísmo, incomprensión e intolerancia con los demás, para testimoniar a Jesús, al Reino de Dios, en aquellos que podamos ser especialmente útiles por nuestras capacidades. Esto implica abrirnos; el ¡Éfeta!, es el grito que nos hace Jesús, para que lo Formemos en nuestro corazón, para vivir el plan de Dios en cada uno de nosotros.

Llama la atención, que Jesús lleva aparte al sordo tartamudo para sanarlo, pues para Él, TODOS SOMOS VIP, dándonos a entender que, si bien nuestra fe es comunitaria, la invitación que nos hace es personal (no individual), acorde a personalidad y circunstancias de cada uno.
