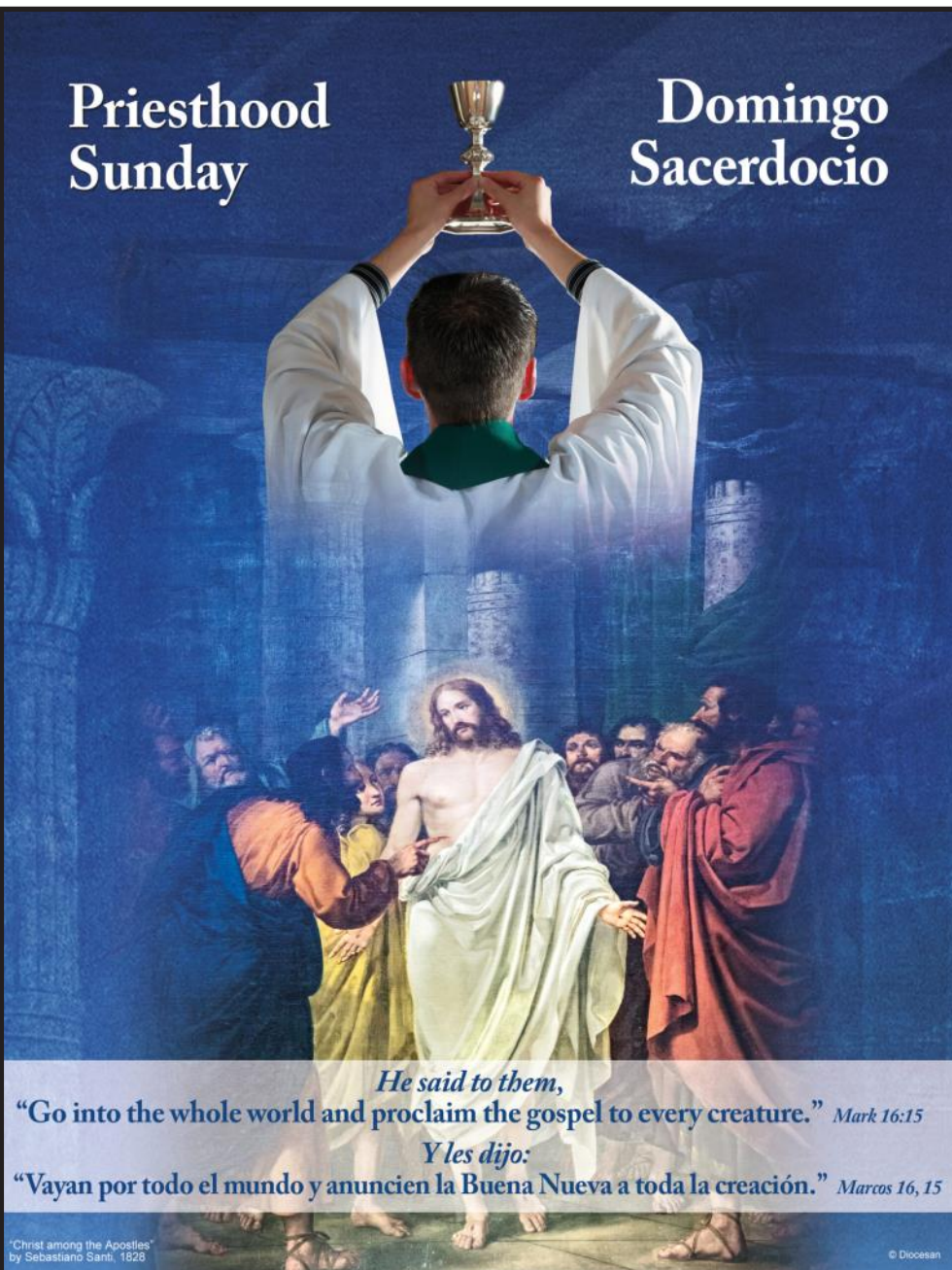

We are asking for donations to help support the Respect Life Ministry, which provides medical assistance, emotional support and resources to expectant mothers and their unborn or new born babies.

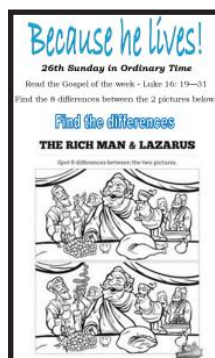

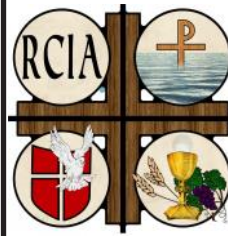
