

All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation and the Church encourages us to pray to the Saints, so they can intercede on our behalf so we too can reach heaven and enjoy the Kingdom of God.

The Mass schedule for All Saints Day is published in the bulletin. Please remember, All Saints Day is a Holy Day of Obligation.

Thursday of this coming week, November 2nd, is All Souls Day. We pray for the members of our church that are no longer with us and perhaps still on their way to heaven. All Souls Day is not a Holy Day of Obligation, though the Church encourages us to pray for those who still need our intercessions. Our bulletin lists the schedule of Masses for All Souls Day, for those who can join us.

In addition to the Masses at St. Henry Church on All Souls Day, the Catholic Cemeteries of the Archdiocese of Miami will continue its tradition of celebrating Mass on the Feast of All Souls for those who wish to attend.

Archbishop Thomas G. Wenski will be celebrating Mass at Our Lady of Mercy Cemetery in the parish of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Doral and Bishop Peter Baldacchino will celebrate Mass at Our Lady Queen of Heaven in North Lauderdale for those who wish to participate in these Masses and visit the cemeteries. Both Masses will be celebrated at 10:00am on Thursday, November 2nd.

Regardless of where you attend Mass, we encourage everyone to remember and pray for their loved ones and those who may have been forgotten.

The following Sunday, November 5th, the Archdiocese of Miami cemeteries will celebrate National Catholic Cemetery Sunday with an open house including informational sessions, tours and a special Rosary at 3:00pm. All are welcome to visit and participate in these events and celebrations.
